? THERE ARE TWO WAYS TO PARTICIPATE IN NATIONAL SERVICE FROM ABROAD AS A LONE VOLUNTEER: >>>

1 Making Aliyah – Once you have made Aliyah and want to serve in national service you need to receive an exemption from Army service before you can begin.

2 A yearlong volunteer's visa

Lone volunteers are very close to our hearts and we strive to provide the most comfortable acclimation possible. Each geographical region in the country has a dedicated coordinator in charge of all the volunteers in that region. The supervisors will help make sure there are no issues both in the place of service and at the apartment.

Shlomit offers professional advice to help you find the most suitable service for you and supports you throughout your service. Lone volunteers are housed in unique apartments adapted for new immigrants. Each apartment has Wi-Fi, a washing machine, a hot plate, and electric kettle for Shabbat.

Rights and Benefits for National Service Participants

Financial Benefits:

- Monthly stipend for personal expenses
- Complimentary public transportation throughout the year (both intra-city and inter-city travel)
- **Leave and Time Off:** Annual leave allocation of 22 days during service period

Professional Support:

- Ongoing mentorship and guidance from experienced coordinators
- Transition assistance for civilian life integration post-service
- Professional development and enrichment programs throughout the year
- Religious guidance and support (SHILAT program)

Additional Benefits for Lone Service Participants:

- Financial assistance from the Ministry of Absorption
- Designated scholarships from the National Service Authority
- Additional 15 days of leave for family visitation
- Complimentary Hebrew language instruction (Ulpan) provided by the Ministry of Absorption
